

TERMS OF SERVICE NADI AI (nadi.today)

These Terms govern the use of the NADI AI Interviewer service, related websites, applications, and interfaces. By commencing use of the Service, the user accepts these Terms.

1. Service Operator

The Service is provided by:

- Foreign Enterprise Limited Liability Company Nadi, Republic of Uzbekistan, registration No. 312613718, resident of IT Park Tashkent.

For matters related to the processing of data of users in the Russian Federation, the following entity acts on behalf of the operator:

2. The Service

The Service provides the user with digital functions for creation, storage, processing, organization, and display of user content, as well as other functions available through the Service interface.

Certain functions of the Service may involve automated data processing. The results of such processing are informational in nature and are provided without any guarantee of absolute accuracy, completeness, or fitness for the user's particular purpose.

3. Registration and Access

Use of certain functions may require creation of an account or completion of an authentication procedure. The operator may offer different sign-in methods, including a one-time code and authentication via third-party providers.

The user must provide accurate information, keep it up to date, and maintain the confidentiality of the means of access to the account.

4. User Content

The user independently determines the content they upload or transmit and is responsible for the lawfulness of its use, including the existence of all necessary rights, consents, and permissions.

The user retains rights to their content to the extent provided by law. For the period of use of the Service, the user grants the operator the right to use such content to the extent necessary for operation of the Service, performance of the contract, security, and technical support.

5. Personal Data and Cross-Border Transfer

The processing of personal data is governed by the Privacy Policy, which forms an integral part of these Terms.

Use of the Service involves the processing of personal data and, where necessary, the cross-border transfer of such data for the purpose of providing the Service. By commencing use of the Service, the user confirms that they have read the Privacy Policy and consents to such processing and transfer to the extent necessary for operation of the Service. Where applicable law requires separate consent, such consent shall be requested additionally.

For users to whom the legislation of the Russian Federation on localization of personal data applies, the operator uses Russian infrastructure to the extent required by law. For operation of certain

Service functions, infrastructure located outside the Russian Federation may be used in accordance with applicable law and the Privacy Policy.

For users in the Russian Federation, the operator may use Yandex technologies, including for authentication and for placing data within the Russian processing environment.

6. Acceptable Use

- it is prohibited to use the Service in violation of law or the rights of third parties;
- it is prohibited to upload or transmit content for which the user does not hold the necessary rights;
- it is prohibited to interfere with the operation of the Service, circumvent access restrictions, use malicious code, or take actions that create a threat to the security of the Service;
- it is prohibited to use the Service for the unlawful collection, dissemination, or disclosure of personal data of third parties without a proper legal basis.

7. Paid Features

Certain functions of the Service may be provided on a paid basis. The terms of access, fees, payment procedure, renewal, and termination of access shall be specified in the Service interface or in a separate offer of the operator.

8. Intellectual Property

All exclusive rights to the Service, its software, interfaces, design, texts, graphics, and other elements, except for user content, belong to the operator or the respective right holders.

9. Limitation of Liability

The Service is provided on an "as is" and "as available" basis unless otherwise required by mandatory rules of applicable law.

The operator shall not be liable for any inability to use the Service for reasons beyond the operator's control, for the actions of third-party providers, or for consequences arising from the user's use of the results of automated data processing.

10. Suspension and Termination of Access

The operator may restrict or terminate the user's access to the Service in the event of a breach of these Terms, legal requirements, or the rights of third parties, or where there is a threat to the security of the Service.

11. Changes to the Service and the Terms

The operator may modify the scope of Service functions, the interface, the technical conditions of use, and these Terms. A new version shall apply from the date of publication or from any other date specified therein.

12. Governing Law and Disputes

Unless otherwise required by mandatory rules of applicable law, these Terms shall be governed by the law of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Disputes shall be resolved through negotiations. If no agreement is reached, the dispute shall be referred to the competent court at the operator's place of establishment, unless otherwise required by mandatory rules of applicable law.
